Reflections for This Week

I shall ask the Father, and he shall give you another Advocate

By now we are some distance away from Easter, but the season is still permeated with the Easter message: Christ is risen, we are baptised in him. But today a new dimension of the story comes out: Easter is not complete until the risen Lord has returned to the Father and sent the Holy Spirit. So in the Gospel today we begin two weeks of looking forward to the coming of that 'Spirit of truth' which sets us apart from the world. This is a Spirit of power, which flows through the life of the Church, enabling its members to 'proclaim the Christ' and, dwelling in our hearts, to live in the midst of the world's slander and accusations.

Marriage Matters: Listen to Jesus within ourselves and within our partner: is in me and in you! In marriage, we are especially called to honour that presence in our spouse every day. There may be times when we hurt each other or take each other for granted, leading to feelings of jealousy and resentment, often to arguments. At times like this the call is for forgiveness, for healing, for affirmation.

Think Vocation: The Lord said, "If you love me you will keep my commandments". In the love of the Risen Christ we are all called to follow his commandments, expressed through the Church

Heating at St Luke's Church

Back in January, we reported that we had permission from the Diocesan Trustees Property Committee to replace the defunct heating system with something similar at an estimated cost of £100,000. It was subsequently decided that we should take the opportunity to redo the covering of the sacristy roof and so the project has been broken down into three stages.

The removal of the old system has been completed this week at a cost of around £11,000. The re-roofing will be done later this month at a cost of around £32,000. Tenders for the final stage (building and installing the new system) were due in this week and are currently being assessed. However, we are aware that the manufacturer of the actual heating unit has a lead-in time of 8 to 10 weeks. So, it could be August before the installation begins.




