### **Reflections for This Week**

# God sent his Son so that through him the world might be saved

We begin our summer 'Ordinary Time' by celebrating a strange feast - not of a particular saint or event, but of the awesome paradoxes of our God, the Three-in-One, Father, Son and Spirit: so immeasurably distant, yet so amazingly close, so full of power and so full of love. It is love that is the key to the mystery: the revelation of God, to Moses and in Jesus Christ, the Son of God, shows a perfect love - a perfect unity. In the beginning, in the story of Creation in Genesis, God made man and woman 'in the image and likeness of God', to live together as a community of love. So too, the Church is an image of this perfection of community which is Father, Son and Spirit. We, as many members of one Church, strive in our everyday lives to imitate God who is Three and One, perfect unity and perfect love.

Marriage Matters: *Be united and live in peace*: In today's readings, God is revealed as full of compassion, tenderness and love for His people. Through the sacrament of marriage, we are called to reflect these qualities through our relationship with each other. When we are irritated and react angrily, it is important that we look at ourselves together, trying to recognise why, and seek to correct the causes.

**Think Vocation:** "Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit." By faithfully following our vocations, whatever they may be, we give glory to God. Try and encourage someone with this message during the week.

### **Helping Hand Fund**

Since this fund was launched in October 2020, it has raised £6268 and has distributed £4838.

The fund is currently supporting a number of families in ensuring their children can participate in educational trips. Traditionally it has offered support at Christmas and with provision of school uniform.

Communion Under Both Kinds: Back in March we informed you that the Bishops' Conference had removed the restriction on receiving from the Chalice (imposed as a result of Covid) and that Bishop John had therefore given permission for parishes to re-introduce Communion Under Both Kinds from Maundy Thursday (if judged to be appropriate). At that time, we indicated that we would do some catechesis about this after Easter (via the newsletter), with a view to potentially reintroducing it in this parish from the Feast of Corpus Christi (next weekend). The reason that we haven't gone ahead with the catechesis, and are therefore not re-introducing it at present, is because the only comments we have received about it over the past few months were all advising us not to go ahead with this for the foreseeable future but to leave things as they are. We can review it again at a point when (if) people begin to feel safer about this practice.

**Ecclesiastical Education Fund:** Thank you for your donations to this fund for the training of future priests and deacons. In addition to the £600.16 raised in the special collection on Good Shepherd Sunday, there were contactless donations amounting to £160 and some further individual offerings amounting to £205, bringing this year's total from the parish to £965.16. Much appreciated.
