Reflections for This Week

Let them both grow till the harvest

There is no room in a good field for weeds and rubbish: so in the Kingdom of Heaven, there is no room for 'all things that provoke offences, and all who do evil'. They must be got rid of, for the sake of the good wheat, for the sake of the good subjects of the kingdom. But this weeding out will not take place until harvest time - in case one piece of good wheat is destroyed with the weeds. This shows the mercy of God: everyone has chance after chance to prove that they are wheat, not darnel; there are no quick judgements in the kingdom of heaven, and things are never as black and white as we think. Only at the end of time will evil stand out clearly, so that it can be disposed of, and only the Son of Man can judge.

Marriage Matters: *Attentive listening:* The Gospel today raises questions about our ability 'to listen'. We easily hear criticism in a comment, or a question which often puts us at odds with each other. But if we listen with our hearts, in the way Jesus commanded us to do, we are enabled, in all our relationships, to follow His command "...listen, anyone who has ears".

Think Vocation: We pray that with dedicated spirits, we will beg the Lord of the Harvest to provide an abundance of vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life in our diocese who will help gather the wheat of souls into His barn.

World Youth Day: Thank you for your support last weekend for the three young people from our parish who will be attending the World Youth Day in Lisbon this August. Between their raffle and the collection baskets, they raised £945.35. This means they have raised about a third of the cost through that appeal and raffle. We are also supporting them with £300 each from the Youth Pilgrimage Fund (established last year when Fr Mark did his sponsored cycle to Lourdes) and they have also been given £100 each by a parishioner. That leaves roughly a third of the cost for them to contribute themselves.

Church Heating (SL): This week we received a cheque for £4900 from the Benefact Trust as a contribution towards the cost of our new heating system. This was applied for by our Diocesan Grant and Bid Writer, who has also applied to another fund on our behalf towards the cost of the new roof on the sacristy (Fingers Crossed!). As you know, the old heating system has been removed and the roofing work is completed. We were told this week that the manufacturer hopes to have the new heating unit ready by the end of August and then the contractor will begin the installation in early September. So, we should be able to look forward to a warmer winter than the last two!

Summer Holidays: As our schools have now broken up for the summer, we wish all who are involved in them a good relaxing break. We thank all members of staff for all their professional dedication and hard work during the last academic year.

We pray for all our Year 6 pupils, Year 11 pupils and our Sixth Form students who are moving on. We ask that they may be given guidance and encouragement as they continue their journeys.
