Reflections for This Week

Once a sinner, always a sinner. That seems to be the attitude of the self-righteous in the first reading and the Gospel; they object that God is unjust, because he gives sinners another chance. But God tells them quite clearly that such attitudes are the real injustice - to allow prejudice and hardness of heart to come between repentance and forgiveness. The words of Christ in the Gospel must have struck a chill into the hard hearts of the so-called righteous chief priests - even today they can make us stop and think: Prostitutes are making their way into the kingdom of God before you. All our outward show matters little, if it does not correspond with what is deep in our hearts; all our words are meaningless, if they do not correspond with the way we live our lives.

Marriage Matters: *Maintain a common purpose:* Remember our courting days and the long, thrilling conversations we had about our future together. They were part of our falling in love and of establishing a common purpose in married life. St Paul reminds us of the mark of a Christian: "Be united in your convictions and your love, with a common purpose and a common mind."

Think Vocation: St Paul speaks today of the need to have a common purpose and a common mind. Our Christian vocation should lead us to discover and carry out God's purpose for us. Our minds should focus on Christ which will lead us to put other people first and purify ourselves of conceit.

Friday is Family Fast Day, a day we can pray, give and eat simply in solidarity with our global family. With extreme disasters like flooding happening more and more, whatever support we can give is needed now more than ever. The work of CAFOD, undertaken with our support, embodies the love of Christ himself, addressing the biggest needs of humanity and caring for our common home with our response to the cry of the earth and the cry of the poor. CAFOD's work is faith put into action.
